2025 Development of three geographically oriented sets of interactive maps and tables were developed in June. Here is a summary:

CityTrends showing U.S. by city Vintage 2025 population estimates. 2020 annually through 2025.

Metros (Vintage 2023 Core-Based Statistical Areas) showing U.S. by metropolitan statistical area and micropolitan statistical area, and component counties Vintage 2025 population estimates and components of change. 2020 annually through 2025.

Looking ahead, these tables will be updated annually using Vintage 2026 data that become available in 2027. The Vintage 2026 data start to become available with national and states estimates released in December 2026. 2020 annually through 2026.
